Whenever they've been here, even for just 15-day medication course, they were quite keen to learn and had many interactive sessions with us. And Geeta completed her 10<sup>th</sup> class board exams this year with 80% which has been a very proud moment for all of us.

Naveen is another kid who is always eagerly waiting for the school to start in the morning. On the days when we are not at the school, he would be impatiently enquiring about us to his mom and other hospital staff. On the days when we are here and if he's supposed to be on IV, he would request the doctors to postpone his chemotherapy to the next day.
