We are happy to announce that out of a total of 8 children who appeared for the SSLC/Class X exams this year, under the aegis of the scholarship program this year, 4 children received more than 65% and 2 children got above 55% marks. Of the 3 children who appeared for the 2nd PUC, 1 scored 54% and another 94% marks.




BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS:
